Applications

- Return the attached application via email or regular post.
- Applications will be processed in the order which they are received.
- Once your application is approved you will be sent an invoice via email, if you do not use email an invoice can be printed and mailed but you **MUST** make that request on your application.
- Applications are not considered complete until payments are received and cleared. We **STRONGLY** suggest paying online via the Square invoice for this reason.

Hours

- The Festival hours for vendors are Friday, July 24th, 5PM - 10PM, Saturday, July 25th, 11AM-9PM and Sunday, July 26th, 11AM-6PM.
- All Vendors: We will have overnight security Friday & Saturday night - however, the Festival is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged goods/tents/canopies. We recommend that you take any valuables with you during the overnight hours.
- We ask the Vendors to remain open for the duration of the event. We understand Saturday is a long day, but there is a large surge in attendees during the evening leading up to our fireworks show.
- Be prepared for rain or wind.

Your space

- All vendors will be allotted a 10 foot square area unless you have made prior arrangements with us. Tents, tables, chairs, etc. are the responsibility of the Vendor. Extra space may be purchased.
- Sides will only be allowed in case of bad weather. Tents must remain open with a clear view to the businesses behind them.
- If your assigned space is in the street or on the sidewalk you **MUST** remain in the specified area. The placement is very specific to allow for the appropriate distance **REQUIRED** by the state regarding our Emergency Action Plan. Please be aware of and respect your boundaries.

Parking & Helpers

- All vendors and their helpers will be able to drop off merchandise and/or equipment for set-up. Once you have unloaded, we ask that you remove your vehicle from the blockaded area and find appropriate parking.
- Failure to follow this process will result in fines and or expulsion from future events.
